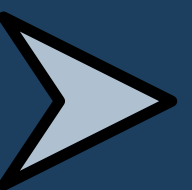

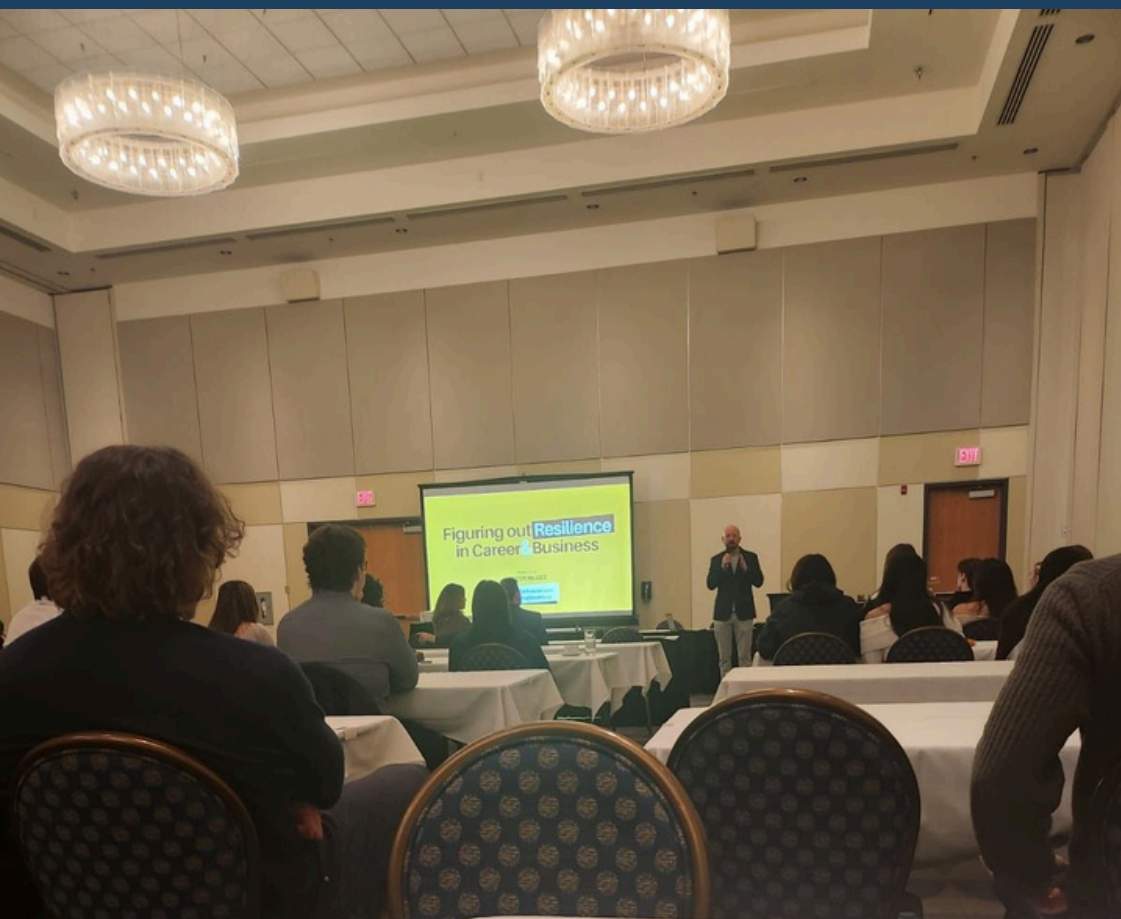




# February 2025

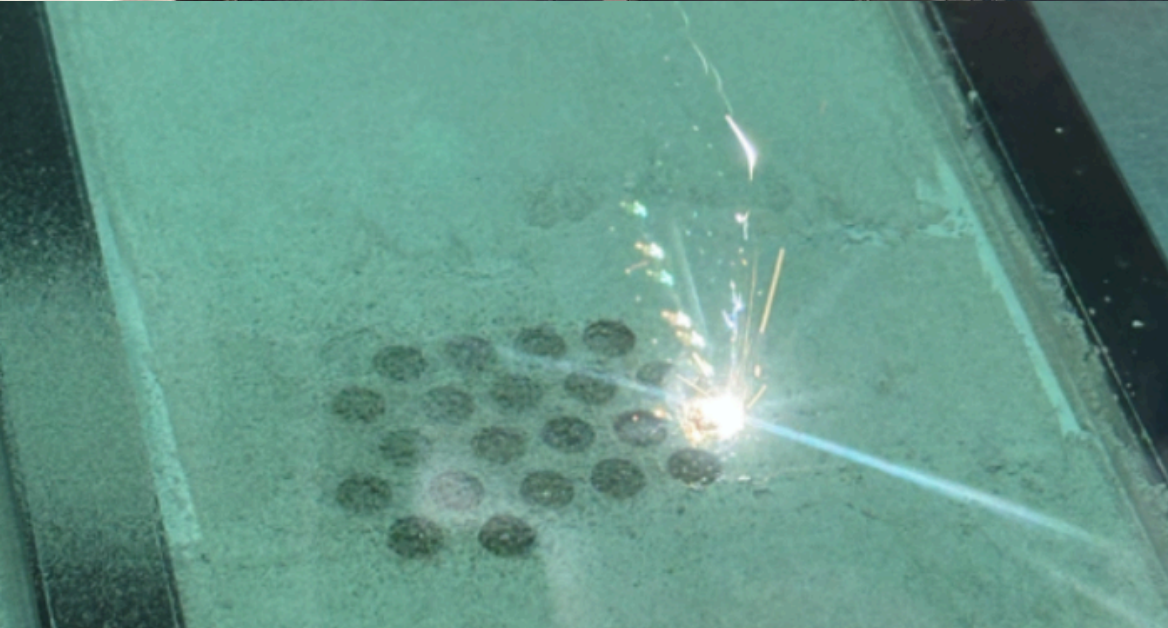
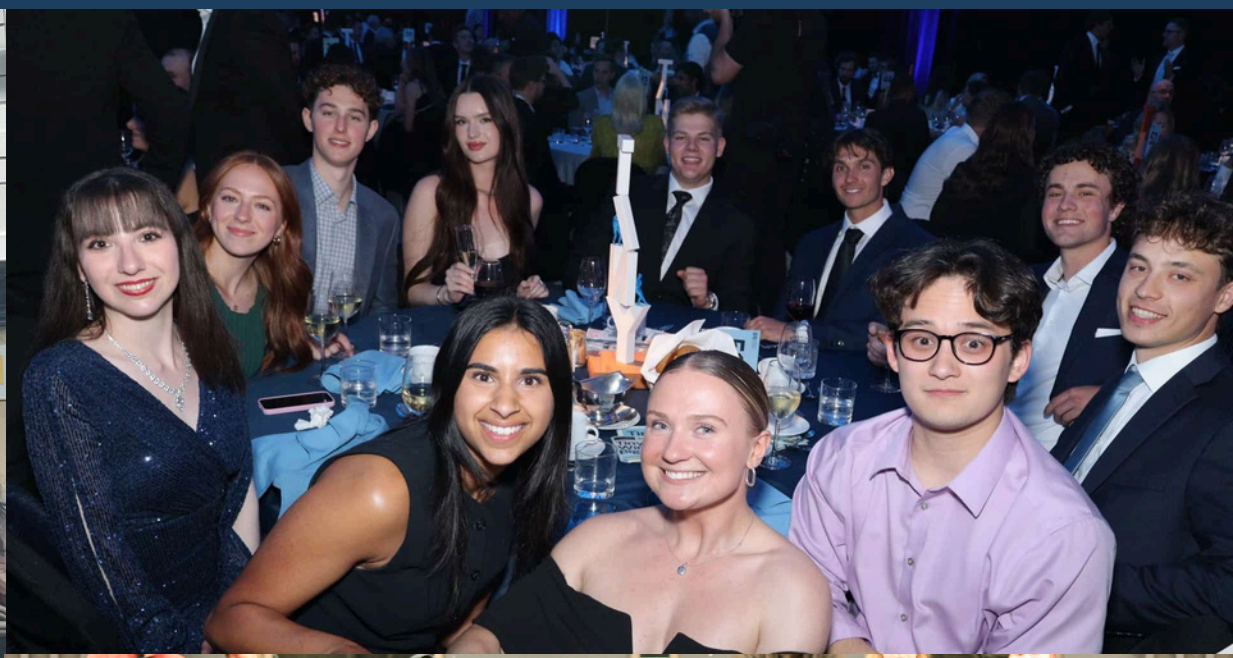




# May 2025
